Inspired by Thee is building a community of support for those who have experienced loss. In addition to online resources, we provide financial support for extraordinary U.S high school and college students, in the form of merit based scholarships.

Eligibility:

The Made in the D Community Scholarship will be awarded to a candidate for graduation from an accredited public or private high school in the Detroit metropolitan area who is helping to shape the future of the city. The award recognizes students that have at least a 3.3 GPA, have demonstrated outstanding leadership, have given back by participating in community service activities within the Detroit metropolitan area or have an established business or nonprofit organization within the Detroit metropolitan area. The award recipient will receive \$2,000 each year for four years towards an undergraduate degree at an accredited four-year college or university and a \$1000 grant upon graduation towards supporting the growth objectives of the scholarship recipient's business/nonprofit.

Application Process:

Submission of a completed Inspired by Thee **Made in the D Community Scholarship Application** consisting of the following:

- Completed application signed by both the student and a parent or legal guardian
- 300 500 words typed essay response
- Two Letters of Recommendation (one must be from a teacher or school counselor)
- Official high school transcript
- Video (3 -5 minutes) about how you support the Detroit community (optional)

All items should be submitted by Monday, March 30, 2018 electronically to jrobinson@inspiredbythee.com or mailed in an envelope postmarked no later than Monday, March 30, 2018 to Inspired by Thee, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 194, Flat Rock, MI 48134.
