The Inspired by Thee Eagle Award will be presented to a graduating high school senior or a college student (currently enrolled in an accredited four year college or university), who has been nominated by their teacher, school counselor, professor, or a community leader, for their leadership, outstanding community service and ability to rise above adversity. Applicants must have experienced the loss of a sibling, parent or caregiver.

Eligibility:

- Minimum 3.33 GPA (high school) or 3.0 (college)
- Demonstrate financial need
- High school applicants must reside in the Michigan Tri-County (Wayne, Oakland and Macomb) area and Washtenaw County
- College students must have graduated from a high school in the aforementioned counties
- Nominated by their teacher, school counselor, professor, or a community leader for their leadership, outstanding community service and ability to rise above adversity

Nomination Process:

Submission of a completed Inspired by Thee Eagle Award Nomination Form consisting of the following:

Individual Nominating Student should submit the following information by May 24, 2020:

- Completed nomination form
- 500 words or less nomination essay

Nominated Student should submit supplemental documentation below by June 7, 2020:

- High school or college transcript
- Statement of financial need
